On behalf of our membership of working appraisers, the undersigned organizations recognize and send our appreciation to the Federal Finance Housing Agency for formulating a strategic plan for the conservatorships of Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac.

Since the plan does touch slightly on appraisals and appraisal data, we would like to briefly comment in this regard.

The stated continuing important role of the Entities in maintaining a healthy and fiscally responsible national housing market inevitably requires a highly competent appraisal profession. As we are state appraisal organizations from across the country, our membership encompasses a broad swath of the individual field appraisers who provide the appraisals to support the ongoing loan decisions made by the Entities. FHFA expressed within the Strategic Plan a desire to involve the various stakeholders. We would like to offer our assistance and advice in any way possible to help meet that goal. (For example, it would seem valuable to all concerned for us to promulgate to our members the findings regarding the most common appraisal reporting errors.) While data driven systems are being developed to oversee and maintain appraisal processes, our membership could be a significant resource for procedural development, successful implementation and practical application. Education and professional peer assistance could also be developed in conjunction with any of these programs in order to maintain the high standards both the Entities and our members are eager to preserve.
